CORRESPONDENCE:

Letter from Attorney McNealis stating he received the transcript and filed Certification of Record with Luzerne County Court of Common Pleas. Sent to Stell Enterprises, Smith Blacktopping, Galbiati Paving, Pennsy Supply, (30,550.00) Ralph Petrill (22,500.00), Bill Dolinski, R C Young, C. Osborne and Edgar Getz. Only received 2 back Pennsy and Petrill. I am requesting Council make a motion toward the work to the lowest responsible bidder. There was also a bid received from C. Osborne of

\$18,000.00 but Council decided that he had not used the proper bid package and his dollar amounts could not be verified.

LAKE MANAGEMENT Shaun Kuter – the fecal count numbers have come back in line and are no longer an issue. Lily pads have been sprayed.

RECORDS/ROADS Paul Rogan a discussion was held regarding the pothole patching and/or paving after hearing the 2 bids. It was decided to go with Ralph Petrill.

A Motion was made by Rogan and 2nd by Johnson to retain Ralph Petrill to do the pothole patching at a cost not to exceed \$22,500.00. Roll call: Rogan, aye, Johnson, aye, Kuter, aye, Rosenstock, aye. All ayes none opposed, motion carried.

MAYOR- Thanked everyone for the well wishes with his recent hospital stay.

DAM -Rob Johnson- Addressed Dam inspection report from DEP since only one bid has come in and we are under a time constraint he asked for a motion to move forward. A **Motion** was made by Rogan and 2nd By Kuter to hire Bulls Eye to perform the work at a cost not to exceed \$1,820.00 and upon insurance approval from DGK, Roll Call: Rogan, aye, Kuter, aye, Johnson, abstain, Rosenstock, nay. Motion carried. Johnson will call Borton Lawson and will be meeting in the near future with DEP to discuss work at Dam.

RECREATION/SEWER Paul Rogan – Nothing to report Johnson met with Ned McGuire at the tennis courts and Ned would like to head the recreation committee to see if and what can be done to improve the failing conditions there. A **Motion** was made by Johnson and 2nd by Rogan to appoint Ned McGuire head of Recreation. Roll Call: Rogan, aye, Johnson, aye, Kuter, aye. Rosenstock, aye, all ayes, none opposed, Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

The discussion on the Amendment of Ordinance #3 1977 was met with objection from Rosenstock. She feels that the number should not be reduced from 5 to 3 since there are members still willing to serve. Rogan stated that due to the size of Borough and number of residents now and in the future willing and/or able to serve is small that he believes the reduction is valid.

A Motion to advertise the amendment to the Ordinance was made by Rogan and 2nd by Johnson. Roll Call: Rogan, aye, Johnson, aye, Kuter, aye, Rosenstock, nay, 3 ayes, 1 nay motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Rogan advised Council that he is looking into trying to make the Ordinances more user friendly.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Topics of discussion were but not limited to: the Borough scanner, Blatterwort ECO said at the time of spraying they found no evidence of, Tabling of vote for Vice President, Rogan will be handling RTK and Roads for now, tax collector hours, and Beach complaints.

A Motion to adjourn was made by Kuter and 2nd by Johnson all in favor The next meeting will be on August 17, 2015 at 7 p.m.
