SOLICITOR – **Jack Dean**- the 2 hearings scheduled were dismissed plaintiff's Attorney called and asked Borough for a negotiated settlement. The Borough agreed and are awaiting payment and signatures on settlement.

LAKE MANAGEMENT/RECREATION Shaun Kuter – lily pad spraying should begin next week along with additional spraying for Blatterwort. Notices will be posted as to closing of the Lake should that be necessary.

ROADS-Vince Kimsal- phone bids were solicited to 7 only 2 responded. The lowest responsible bidder was Ralph Petrill at a cost of \$8,750.00. Engineering costs for this project can be paid from Liquid Fuels account as long as it stays under 10% of the total project.
