LAKE MANAGEMENT/RECREATION Shaun Kuter water testing has been running fine. The spraying of the lily pads will be done the last week of June with blatterwart to be addressed later after swimming lessons as the Lake must be closed when that takes place. Thanks to Kevin Cronauer and his friends for securing the dock and returning it to the beach and Jasin for refloating it. The playground received 3"of playground mulch and the sliding board was permanently anchored.

ROADS-Vince Kimsal- tree trimming complete on Horseshoe, Marilyn to the turnpike and Darby with removal of several dead and/or broken trees. Any concerns please contact me. **DAM – Paul Rogan-**DOE submitted the Dam underwater inspection report with the following recommendations: 1. Remove silt, timber debris and rock adjacent to intake. Note do not operate valve until removed. 2. Remove existing grating and misc metal pieces installed as a trash rack and replace with a properly designed and installed trash rack. 3. Rebuild downstream

valve and operating stem assay. 4. Upon completion of recommendation 1 & 2, open the valve and flush conduit to remove sediments and small stone to permit a complete video inspection. I will be purchasing a thumb drive to copy full report and recommendations then sending off to DEP.

SEWER: Paul Rogan—Aqua is now offering e-billing for sewer.

RTK/RECORDS: Rich Campbell—marked potholes and will be meeting with contractor for a quote.
