PENN LAKE PARK BOROUGH SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

The Penn Lake Park Borough Special Council meeting was held via the conferencing app, GotoMeeting. Council President Paul Rogan called the meeting to order at approximately 10:05 am and stated the Special Council Meeting was advertised and that the meeting can be recorded.

ROLL CALL: Mayor Debra Krysicki, Council President Paul Rogan, Council members Shaun Kuter, Jill Rosenstock, David Longmore, and John Burden responded.

NEW BUSINESS:

Emergency Declaration- A **Motion** was made by Rogan, 2nd by Rosenstock to enact Resolution 17 of 2020 to extend the Emergency Declaration month to month until no longer needed.

Roll Call: Rogan, Longmore, Rosenstock, Kuter, and Burden all in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.

Mayoral Powers- The Mayor made a recommendation that all incoming visitors quarantine themselves for fourteen days in respect to the residents of Penn Lake Park Borough. Krysicki also recommended residents only leave their homes for medicine, food, doctors' appointments, or gasoline. All public areas including pagoda, beaches, basketball and tennis courts, and playground are closed.

Emergency Management Coordinator- Chris Zwiebel spoke on possible uses for the Community House.

A **Motion** to adjourn was made by Rogan, 2nd by Kuter.

Roll Call all in favor, all ayes, none opposed. Motion carried.
